MOST HAUNTED LIVE AT THE THREE MARINERS

The Three Mariners, run by husband and wife team Roy and Claire, is one of Lancaster's oldest pubs, built in the 13th century. In its 700 year history the pub has seen Henry VIII close the priory, the trial of the Pendle witches and throughout this time it has always been linked to supernatural goings-on. It is for this reason that on Thursday 29th October, the pub was at the centre of the nation's focus when a special Halloween edition of popular ghost-hunting TV show Most Haunted was aired live from the pub.

The pub is well known to local ghost watchers and is a regular stop on the city's haunted history tours, which made it the ideal location to film the show.

The aim was to find "the eight faces of evil" which on this particular night was "the sorcerer." Whilst holding the investigation the team discovered at least 12 spirits, some including the Pendle Witches that were once held at the Lancaster Castle that is situated directly above the public house. During the investigation some members of the team were affected by the paranormal phenomena that was found, and there have been some strange goings-on since!

"We have always suspected strange things happened in this pub," says Roy, Landlord since 2004. "Normally we put it down to the spirits people drink rather than the ones in the building – but we all learned something on Thursday night."
